




#### Directions

- 7) Jonah finally obeyed God and went to Nineveh to do what God said.









# A Little Plant and a Great City

Jonah 3:1-4:11

onah, get up and go to Nineveh," God said. "Speak the message I give you." This time, Jonah went. He walked all day into the city. There he cried out, "In forty days, Nineveh will be torn down."

The people of Nineveh believed God and turned from their sins. Nineveh's king declared, "No one may eat or drink. All must pray to God. Who knows? God may change his mind so we don't die." When God saw this, he did change his mind. He didn't slaughter Nineveh.
