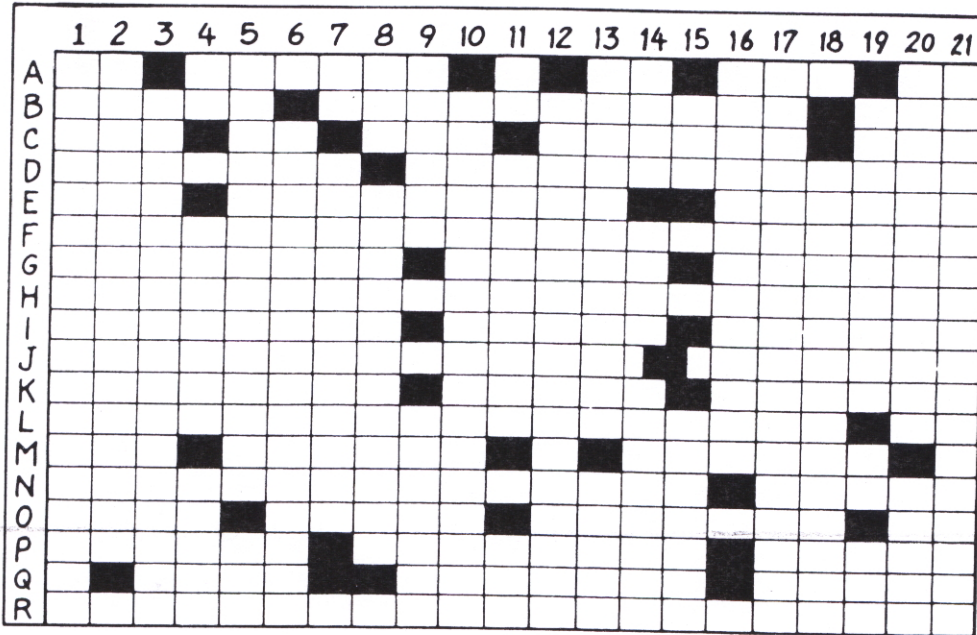

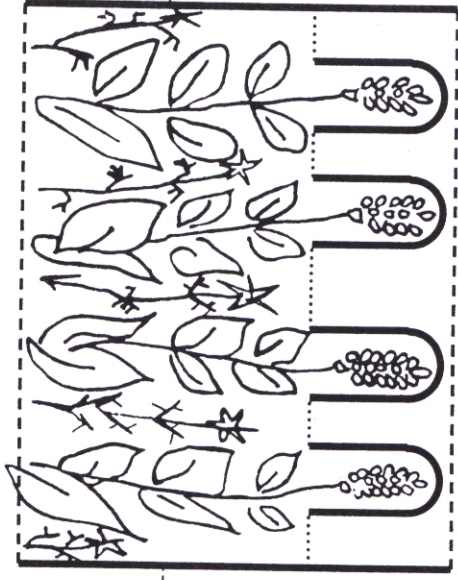
The Wheat and the Weeds
