
Joshua

Deuteronomy 34:1-7; Joshua 1:1-9; 6:1-16



One day, after wandering in the desert for forty years, Moses climbed to a mountain peak to talk to God. As he looked as far as he could see, the Lord spoke, "This is the land I promised to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob."

God let Moses see the land, but he was not allowed to enter. Moses died a

short while later. He was 120 years old.

After Moses was buried, the Lord spoke to a man named Joshua. "Now that my servant Moses is dead, you must lead my people across the Jordan River. Be strong and courageous and lead my people to the land I have promised them. Do not be afraid or discouraged. The Lord is with you wherever you go."

When it was time for the Israelites to enter the city of Jericho, God gave Joshua specific instructions: "Your entire army is to march around the city walls one time each day for six straight days. Seven priests are to lead the march, each carrying a ram's horn."

God gave the people special instructions for the seventh day. At dawn on the seventh day, Joshua ordered his army to march around the walls of Jericho seven times. As the priests blew their trumpets, Joshua commanded the people, "Shout! For the Lord has given you the city!"

The marchers shouted, and the walls came tumbling down. The Israelites charged the city from every side and captured it. The Lord was with Joshua, and his

name became famous throughout the land.

God Tells Moses


Use the color code to color the walls of Jericho coming down.
