At the time Abraham was also very old.



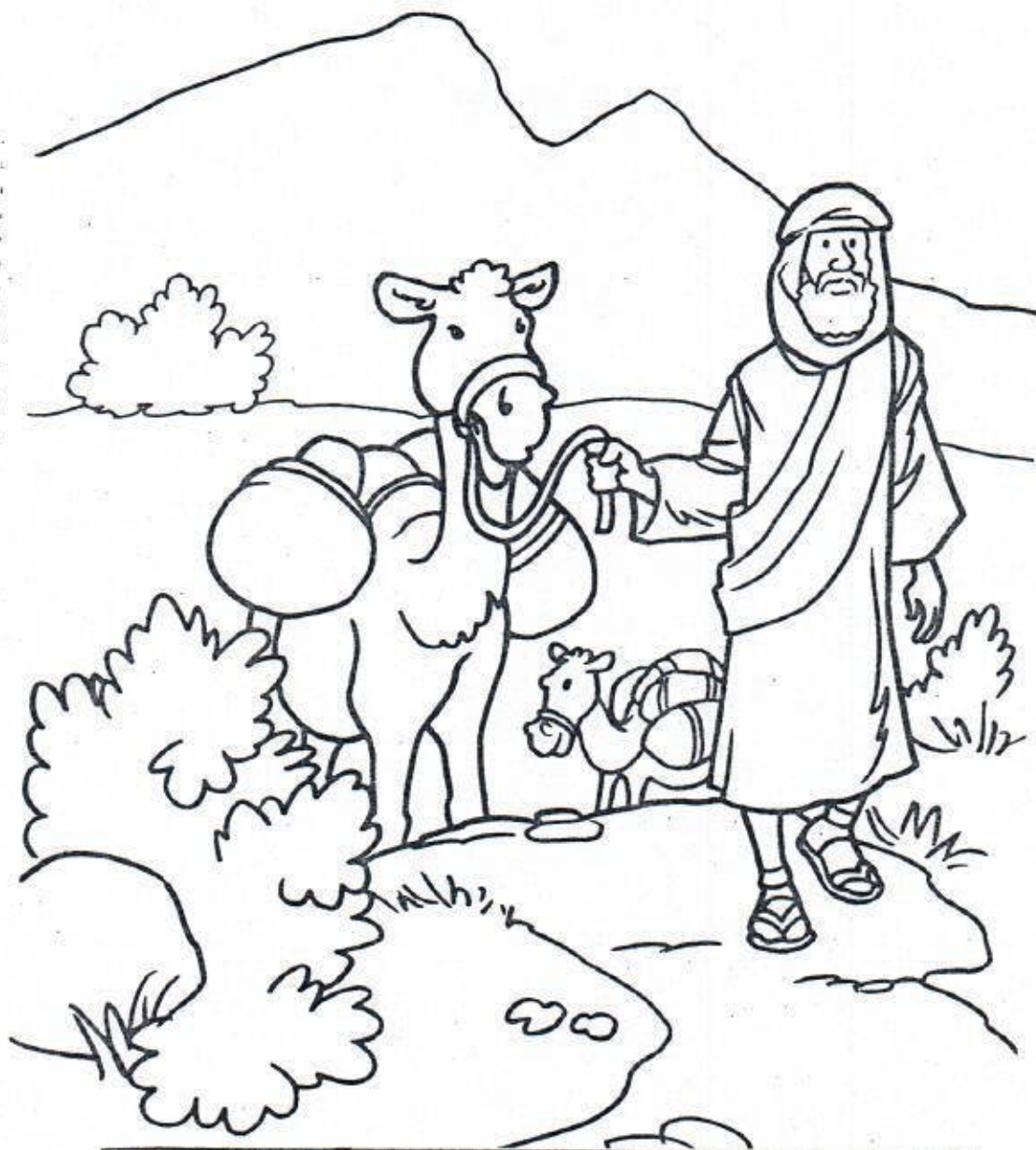
After Sarah died Abraham called for one of his servants and asked him for a favor.
