Jesus and the Children

Jesus and the Children Flip Flap Book

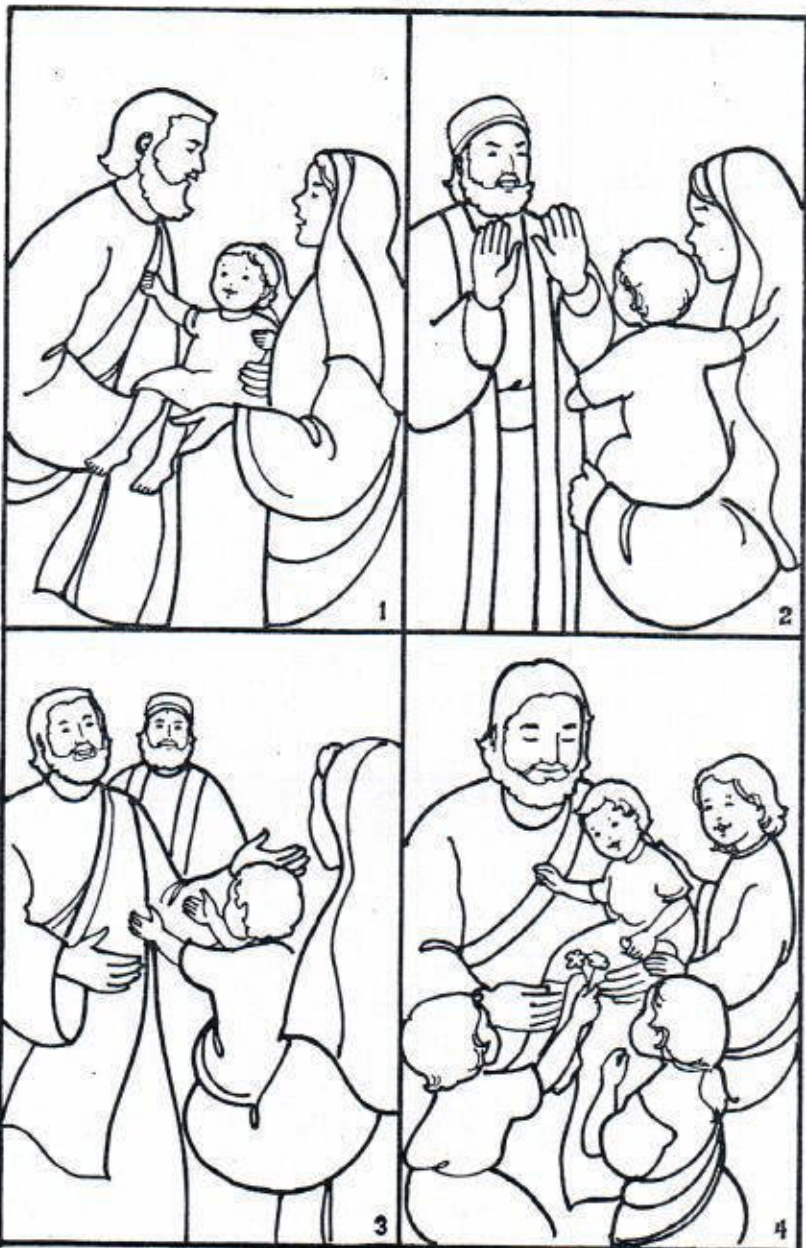
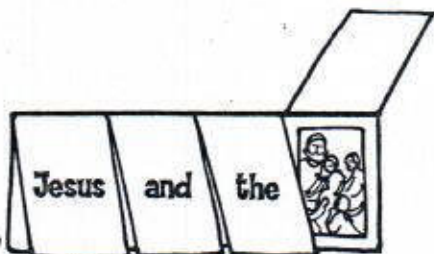
Supplies

copies of the flip flap book for each child
crayons or markers
construction paper (1 sheet per child, any color)
scissors
glue

Directions

Color and cut out each of the four scenes separately. Fold a piece of construction paper in half lengthwise. Cut the top flap of the construction paper into four equal sections, stopping at the fold line (see the example). Each flap should be about 3" wide. Attach the four scenes under each of the four flaps so that a scene appears when each flap is lifted (see the example). Write the words "Jesus and the Children" on the front of the flaps, one word per flap. Use the flip flap book to retell the story of Jesus and the children:

- 1) Mothers were bringing their children to Jesus.
- 2) Jesus' followers told them to leave Him alone.
- 3) Jesus corrected His followers and welcomed the children to come to Him.
- 4) Jesus spent time with the children and showed everyone that He thinks children are very important.

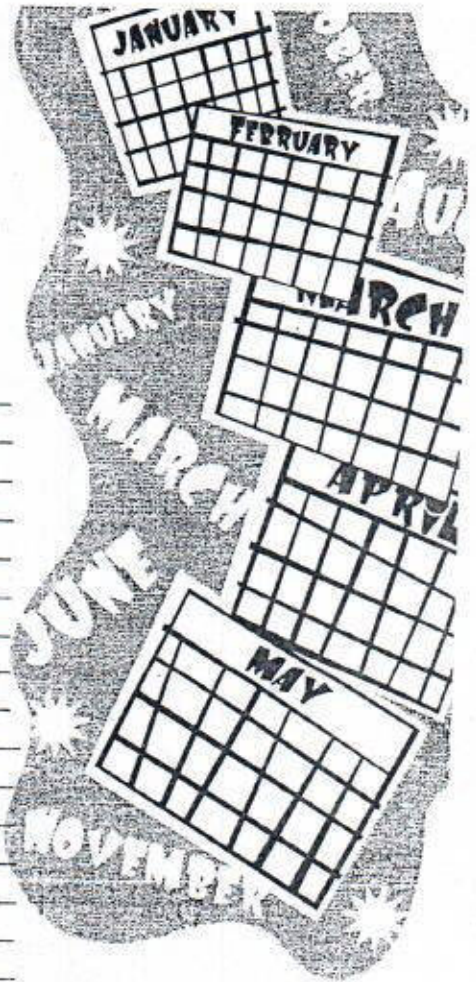


When Did It Happen?
