

The Great Fast

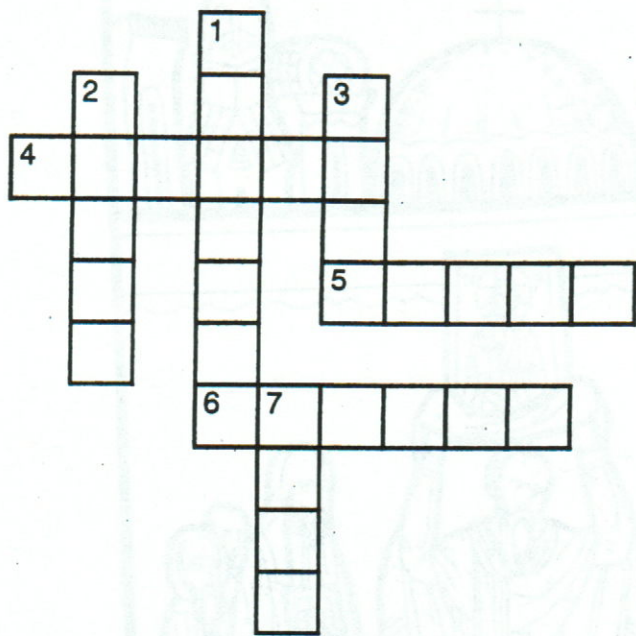
"Be of Good Courage"
