

Eighth Sunday after Pentecost
Matthew 14, 14-22



John 6—Jesus Feeds 5,000 Fish and Bread Mobile

Supplies

copies of the Fish and Bread Mobile for each child
paper plates (1 per child)
crayons or markers
scissors
hole punch
twine or yarn (any color)

Directions

Before class make enough copies of the mobile pieces for each student.

Color and cut out the two fish and the five loaves of bread. Punch holes in each of the seven pieces (in the center, toward the top). Write "Jesus Can Give You What You Need" on the back of the paper plate and punch seven holes, evenly spaced, around the rim of the plate and one in the center of the plate. Using varying lengths of twine or yarn, tie the seven mobile pieces to the rim of the paper plate, alternating between loaves and fish (tie the loaves in order per the numbers in the lower right corners—see the example). Tie a piece of twine or yarn through the center of the plate so the mobile can be hung. Use the Fish and Bread Mobile to retell the story of Jesus feeding 5,000 people.
