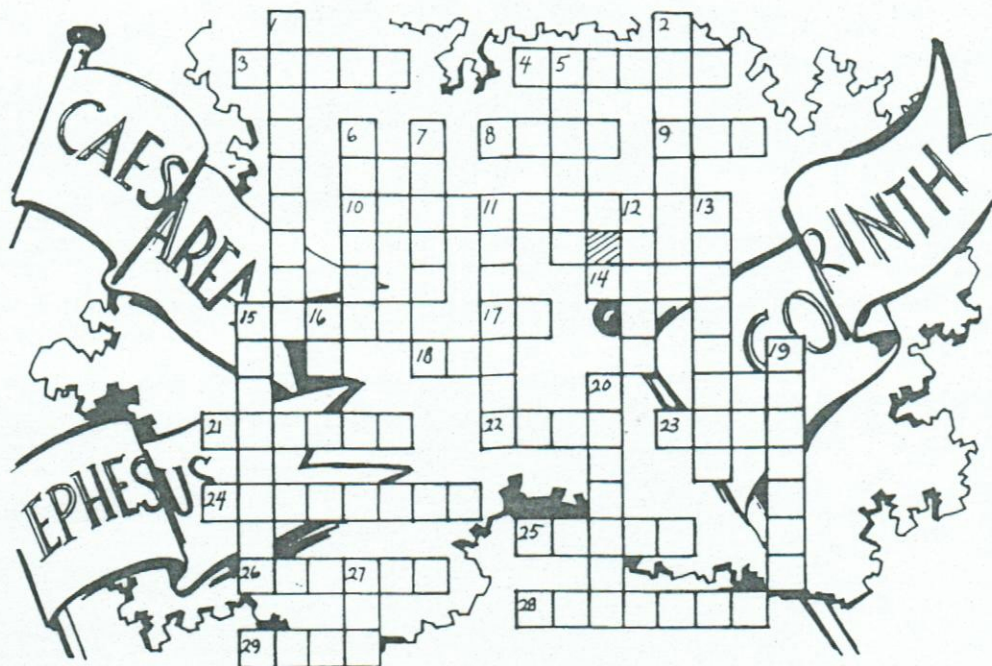

Be kind and loving to each other. Forgive each other just as God forgave you in Christ.

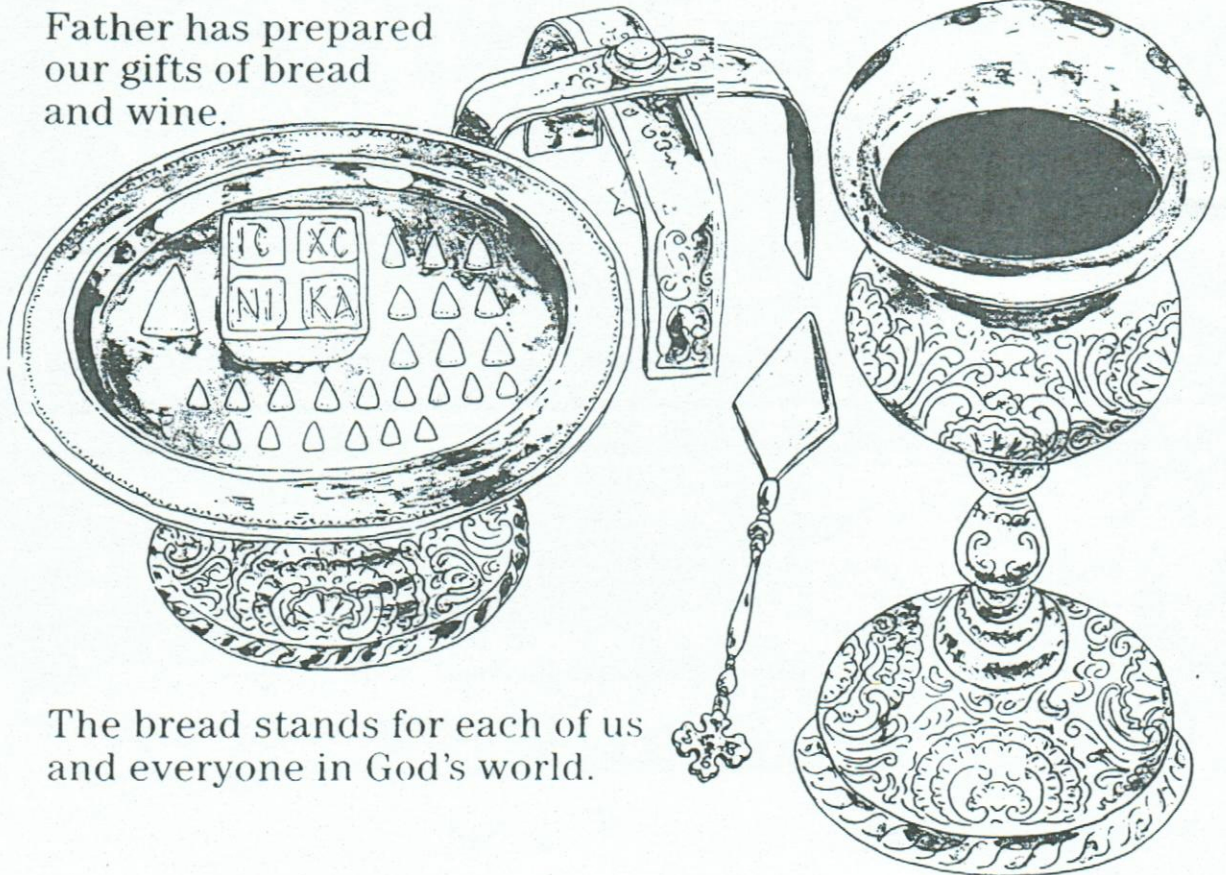

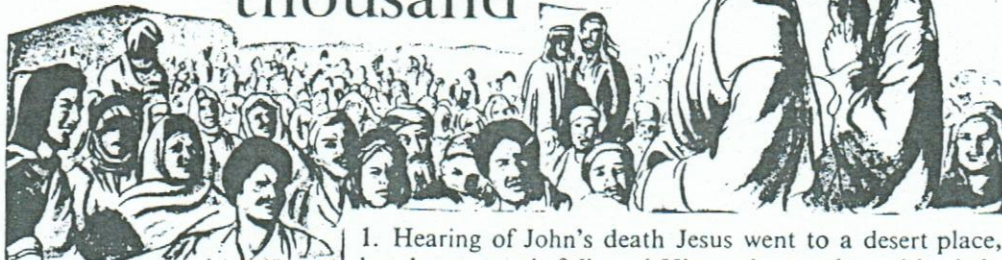

Feeding the five thousand



1. Hearing of John's death Jesus went to a desert place, but huge crowds followed Him to be taught and healed.



2. When evening came His disciples wanted them to be sent away for food. "Feed them yourselves!" said Jesus. Andrew said: "This lad has five loaves and two fishes —"



3. —but what good are they among so many?" For the crowd numbered about five thousand. "Make them sit down," said Jesus, and they did so.



4. Then Jesus took the loaves and fishes and gave thanks. He handed them to the disciples who kept breaking them and distributing them to the people. When all had eaten as much as they wanted, Jesus told the disciples to gather the fragments. Twelve baskets were filled!
