



### DIRECTIONS

- 1. Stress the privilege of having a God who actually hears our prayers and cares about what happens in our lives every day. Say, It's a great feeling to know that there are people around us who love us and will listen anytime we need to talk to them. It's even greater to have a God who is always there and who tells us in the Bible that He is listening.
- 2. Have the students glue page to a sheet of construction paper.
- Instruct them to color the plaque and the stand, then cut them out on the solid lines.
- Show how to fold the stand inward on fold-line. The plaque will set evenly on the stand's handles.
- Suggest to the class that they take their plaques home as a reminder to pray or that they give them to a friend or relative to let them know they are praying for them.
- 6. Close with prayer.
