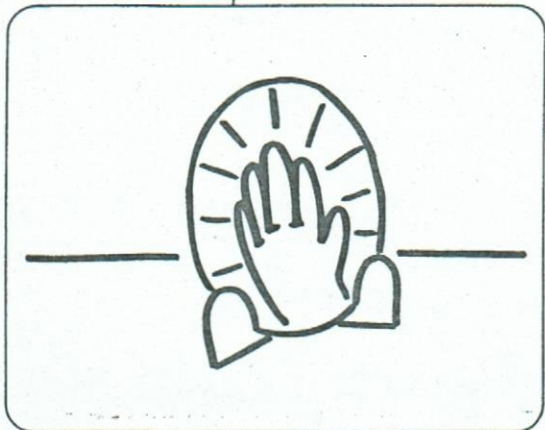


MEMORY VERSE

PRAYER THOUGHT

God hears my prayers.



ITEMS NEEDED



construction paper
scissors
markers
glue

PREPARATION

Duplicate page 16.

DIRECTIONS



1. Stress the privilege of having a God who actually hears our prayers and cares about what happens in our lives every day. Say, **It's a great feeling to know that there are people around us who love us and will listen anytime we need to talk to them. It's even greater to have a God who is always there and who tells us in the Bible that He is listening.**
2. Have the students glue page 16 to a sheet of construction paper.
3. Instruct them to color the plaque and the stand, then cut them out on the solid lines.
4. Show how to fold the stand inward on fold-line. The plaque will set evenly on the stand's handles.
5. Suggest to the class that they take their plaques home as a reminder to pray or that they give them to a friend or relative to let them know they are praying for them.
6. Close with prayer.
