Time to Leave The Ark

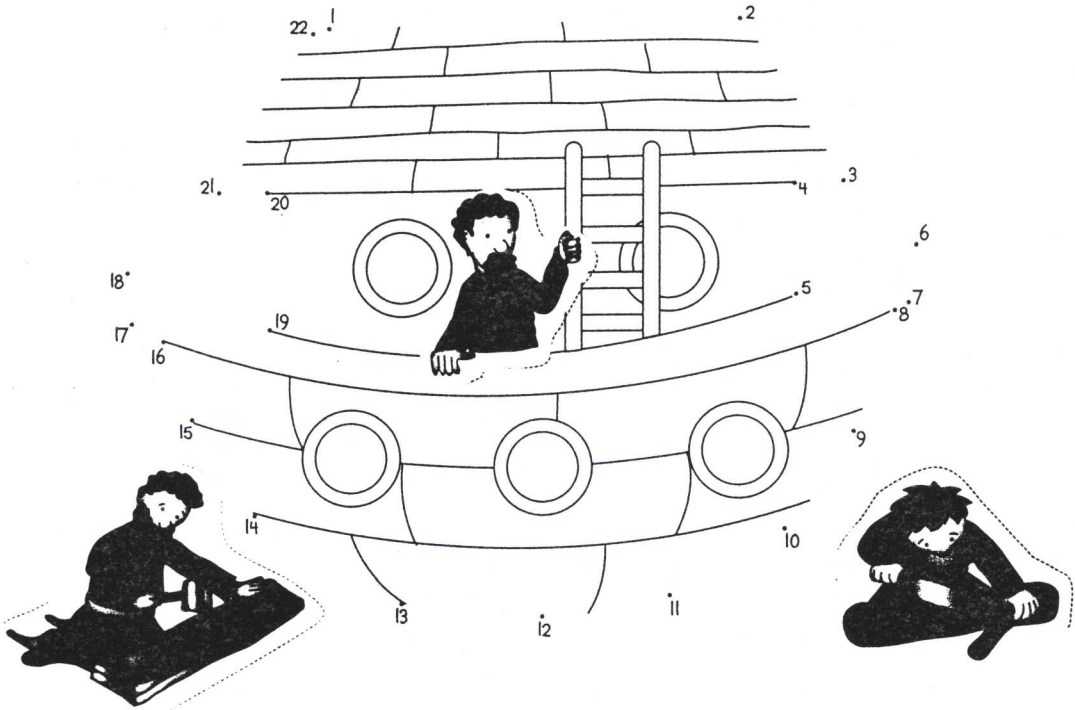

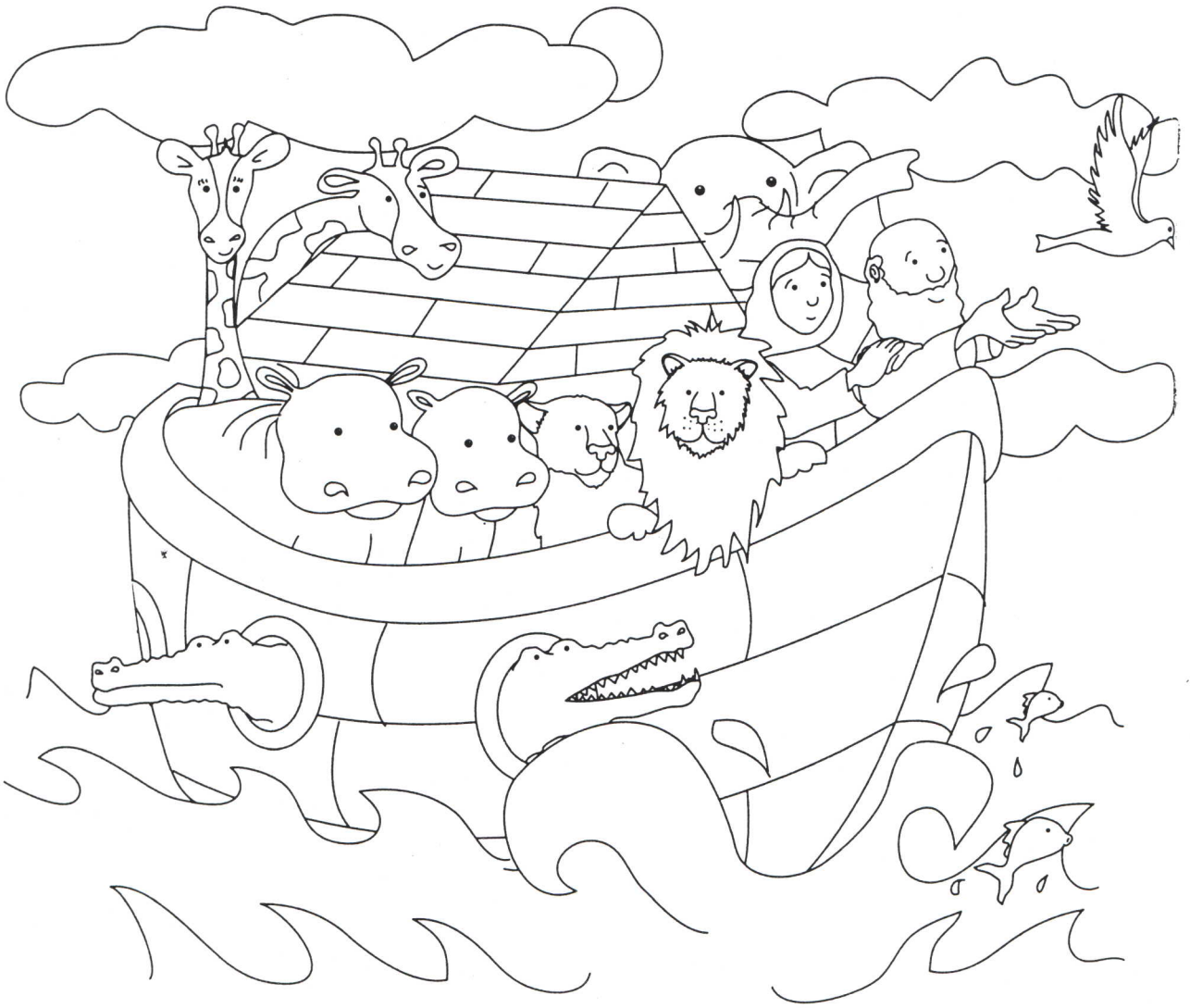




When it stopped raining, Noah sent out a dove to look for dry land.



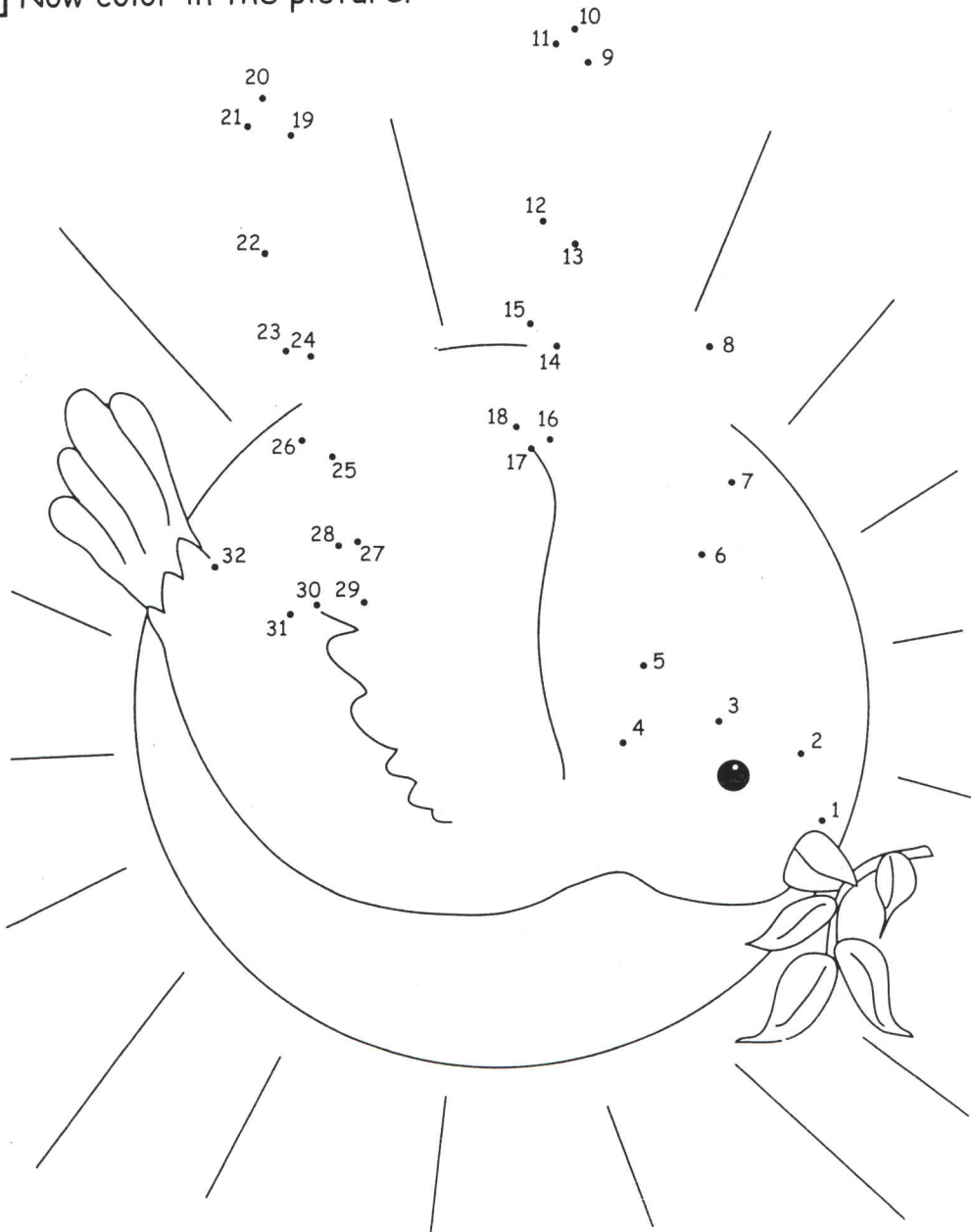

On her second trip, the dove returned to the Ark with an olive branch in her beak. She had found dry land!



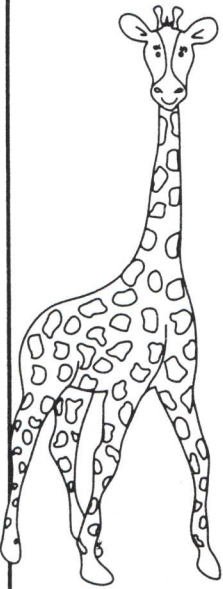

Finally, it was time to leave the Ark! Out tumbled all the animals into the sunshine. God put a beautiful rainbow in the sky, as a sign of His love for the world.

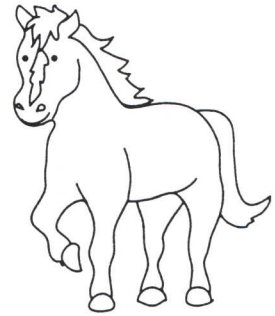
