5. Add these two numbers together.

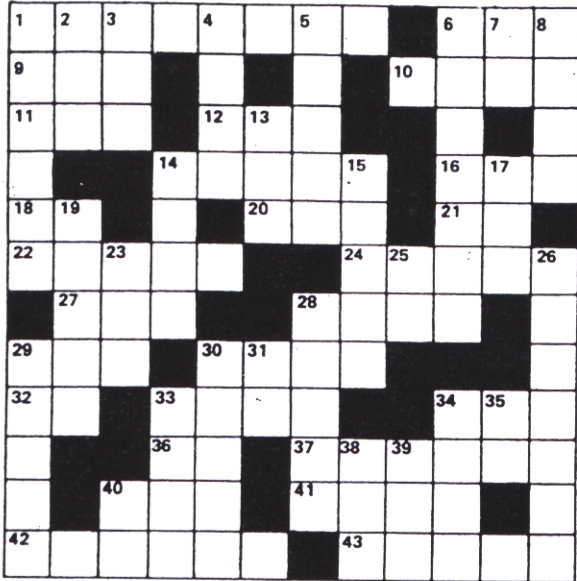
EXAMPLE: $1 + 8 = 9$

CRAZY NUMBER NINE MAGIC TRICK



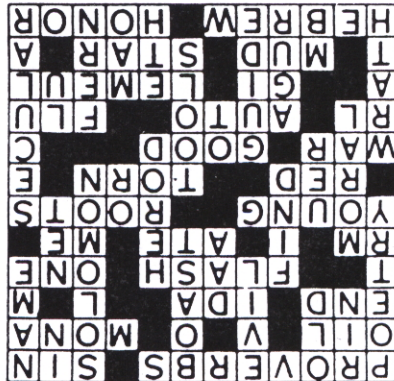
